



Etching Crème Instructions

For etching designs on Glass, Ceramic Glazes, Marble, Slate & Mirrors

ALWAYS USE PROTECTIVE GLOVES, APRON & GOGGLES

- Ensure items to be etched are clean and free from grease.
- 2 Using A Vinyl Cutter

With a vinyl cutter, eg. Silhouette Cameo, cut your design onto an A4 Etch Stencil Sheet. Remove the areas to be etched from the design using a burnishing tool. Apply a transfer sheet to the design and peel back. This will remove the design from the backing paper of the stencil sheet. Apply the graphic on the transfer sheet to your project. Press down firmly and then gently peel back the transfer sheet on itself to remove it.

Using A Scalpel

Cut your design onto an A4 Etch Stencil Sheet using a scalpel. Remove the areas to be etched from the design using a burnishing tool. Apply a transfer sheet to the design and peel back. This will remove the design from the backing paper of the stencil sheet. Apply the graphic on the transfer sheet to your project. Press down firmly and then gently peel back the transfer sheet on itself to remove it. Alternatively if your design is relatively simple apply A4 Etch Stencil Sheet to surface first, then cut in place using a scalpel with a stainless steel blade, being careful not to scratch the surface.

- 3 Ensure stencil is firmly in place and there are no lifting edges. **Remember etching is permanent**. If the stencil is not correctly in place the Etching Crème can seep under the stencil.
- 4 Stir well before use. Cover with a heavy coat of the Etching Crème. Use a squeegee to ensure all parts of the design are covered.
- Wait 15 minutes.
- 6 Using squeegee, remove the Etching Crème and return to the bottle as this can be reused.
- Flush with water to remove any residual cream.
- Remove your stencil underwater to avoid cream getting on non-etched surface.

Storage & Safety

- Store at room temperature.
- Use in a well ventilated area.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- · Use protective gloves, apron and goggles.
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- In the event of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.
- Avoid ingestion. If swallowed drink large quantities of water followed by milk. Do not induce vomiting. Get prompt medical attention.
